## **PEOPLE'S CLIMATE MARCH**

New York City ~ Sunday ~ September 21, 2014

**CAPE COD, MA -** Climate, anti-nuke, and social justice activists as well as ordinary citizens from across the Cape will travel in a bus caravan to New York City on Sunday, September 21, to participate in what is being billed as the largest climate march in history.

The People's Climate March will culminate several days of activity centered around the UN summit on the climate crisis. United Nations Secretary General Ban Ki Moon has called for the summit on September 23rd, where world leaders will be urged to support an ambitious global agreement to dramatically reduce global warming pollution.

While the world is watching, over 750 organizations from across the country are joining together to march in support of an economy that works for the people and the planet; a world safe from the ravages of climate change; a world with good jobs; clean air and water; and healthy communities. The organizations will include business, unions, religious groups, environmental groups, schools, social justice groups and more.

Local endorsers of the march include the Cape Node of 350MA and 350MVI, Falmouth Climate Action Team, Occupy Falmouth, Cape Downwinders, Down Cape Downwinders, the Cape chapter of Womens International League for Peace and Freedom, Cinema Politica, GreenCAPE, Pilgrim Coalition, Climate Action Citizens, POCCA Cape, and the Waquoit Congregational Church. More endorsements are coming in daily.

Buses will make the same day round trip with stops in Harwich, Barnstable, and Sagamore. Seats are available for \$40 RT with financial aid available to anyone who needs it. Off Cape, buses organized by 350Massachusetts will be leaving from across the state on same day and two-day trips (www.350MA.org).
