The Office of Secretary of State Certifies Petition

A Question Will Be On The November Ballot for The Voters of Cape Cod and The Islands

BOSTON, MA - Today representatives from Cape Downwinders delivered a petition containing more than two thousand certified signatures to the Secretary of State in Boston. The petition's request was to include a Public Policy question on the November ballot that would expand the Emergency Planning Zone (EPZ) surrounding the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station to include all of Cape Cod and the Islands.

The petition was immediately certified by the office of the Secretary of State and in November the voters in the Cape Cod and Island Senatorial District will vote on a nonbonding advisory question asking:

Shall the State Senator from this district be instructed to vote in favor of legislation to expand the radiological Plume Exposure Emergency Planning Zone around the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station in Plymouth, an approximately 10 mile-radius area, to include all of Barnstable, Dukes and Nantucket Counties?
