PLYMOUTH, MA - People all across New England will march through the South Shore and metro Boston communities to the State House calling for the closure of the Entergy owned Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station in Plymouth. The goal of the four day event is to raise awareness that Pilgrim is a threat to surrounding communities and if a nuclear accident occurred those communities are in the path of a radioactive plume that could spread throughout the 50 mile danger zone reaching Boston.

The four day march will begin in Plymouth on Saturday, June 13th and culminate with a rally in the Gardner Auditorium at the State House on Tuesday, June 16th.
